1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Italian National Authority will not apply.
- 1.3 The ISA Championship Rules will apply.
- 1.4 The following racing rules will be changed: 28.1, 32, 35, 42.3(c), 60.1(a), 61.3, 62.2, 66, A4, A11 and Race Signals AP and S. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.5 Amendments to any of the rules applying to the regatta must be approved and signed by the ISA Liaison Officer appointed for the event.

2 Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

3 Eligibility and entry

- 3.1 The Masters World Championship is open to all yachts of the International Soling Class of which:
 - a) the helm must be aged at least 50 years on the first scheduled day of racing; and
 - b) the aggregate ages of the crew of three must be at least 120 years on that day.

- 3.2 The Soling Traunsee Cup is open to all yachts of the International Soling Class no matter the age of the crew or skipper.
- 3.3 ISA Membership is obligatory for all crew members. Membership fees will be collected from any crew member failing to present proof of previously paid membership fee.
- 3.4 It is also required that all yachts entering display the ISA sticker for the current year. An additional amount will be collected from the helmsman or representative of any yacht not displaying the ISA sticker of the current year at the appropriate position.
- 3.5 **Registration should be submitted no later than 24. April 2013 and the entry fee should be transferred by then:**

6 Measurement

Yachts will be measured in accordance with ISA Championship Rule 7.0 Measuring and Class Rules 16 and 17. For a yacht to be eligible to race, her valid (the original or a copy of the original) Measurement Form shall be presented at the Race Office, and the helmsman must have satisfied all measurement and registration requirements as specified in this Notice of Race including the submission (at the completion of measurement) of properly completed measurement work sheets. If the Measurement Form cannot be produced before the first race, RRS 78.2 will be applied.

7 First start

Thursday 09th Mai 2013 01:00 pm

8 Last possible start

Saturday 11th Mai 2013 04:00 pm

9 Regatta site / course

9.1 The racing area is the territory of Lake Traunsee in the bay of Ebensee

9.2 The ISA standard racing course will be used (up/down 6 leg with gate and minireach) the one will be shown in the sailing instructions.

10 Scoring

10.1 There will be two separate score lists for single race results for the Masters and the Soling Traunsee Cup

10.2 The Low Points Scoring System of RRS A4 will apply.

10.3 7 races are scheduled of which 5 must be completed to constitute a valid World Masters Championship. 4 races must be completed to constitute a valid Soling Traunsee Cup.

10.4 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 Prizes

11.1 The perpetual Masters World Championship Trophy will be awarded to the best-placed masters team

11.2 Prizes for the first five crews of the Masters World Championship

11.3 Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 Crews of the Soling Traunsee Cup (that is including participants of the Masters Series)

12 Support boats

Support boats are not allowed.

13 Disclaimer

Competitors agree to be bound by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Racing. Competitors agree to take any and all responsibility for the nautical qualities of their boat, the rigging, the crew's ability and the safety equipment. Competitors also agree to take any and all responsibility for damages caused to third persons or their belongings, to themselves or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the Soling Masters WM and Soling Traunsee Cup, relieving of any responsibility the Organizing Authority, the Jury, the International Soling Class Association and all National Soling Class Associations and all persons involved in their organization under whatever qualification and to accept full responsibility for the behaviour and dress of the boat's crew, representatives and guests.

In any case, competitors agree that the Organizing Authority, Segelclub Ebensee, the International Soling Association and all National Soling Class Associations, the sponsors of the Allianz Traunsee Woche and their agents, have no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members, competitors or others, or for the loss or damage to any vessel or property sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Soling Masters WM and Soling Traunsee Cup.

The Organizing Authority reminds the participants that there are commercial shipping traffic in the vicinity of the race area and the participants are expected to observe the IRPCAS in relation to all such vessels.

14 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance cover while racing of not less than 1.500.000 euro for the duration of the regatta
